
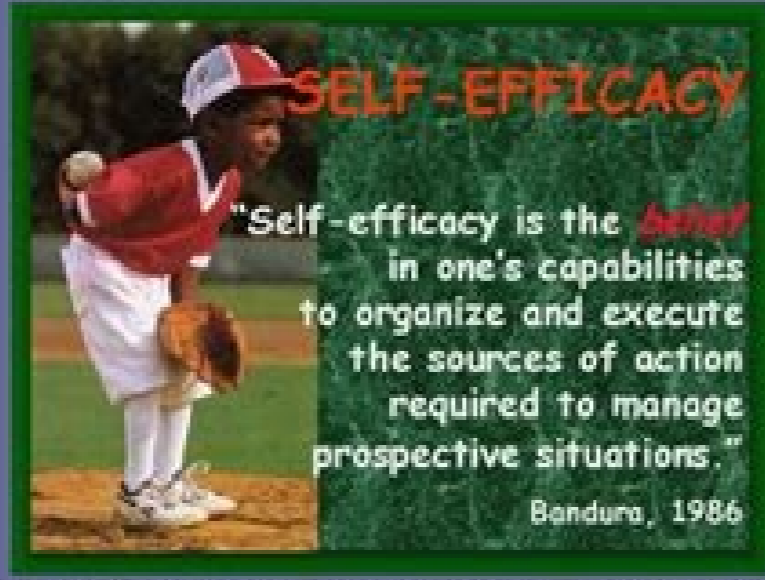


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# Bandura's Theory

- Human beings have specific abilities related to learning that sets them apart from other species.
- Social cognitive theory states that there are three characteristics that are unique to humans:
  - Vicarious consequences (Model and imitate others)
  - Self-efficacy (self reflection)
  - Performance standards and moral conduct (Ability to regulate one's own behavior)

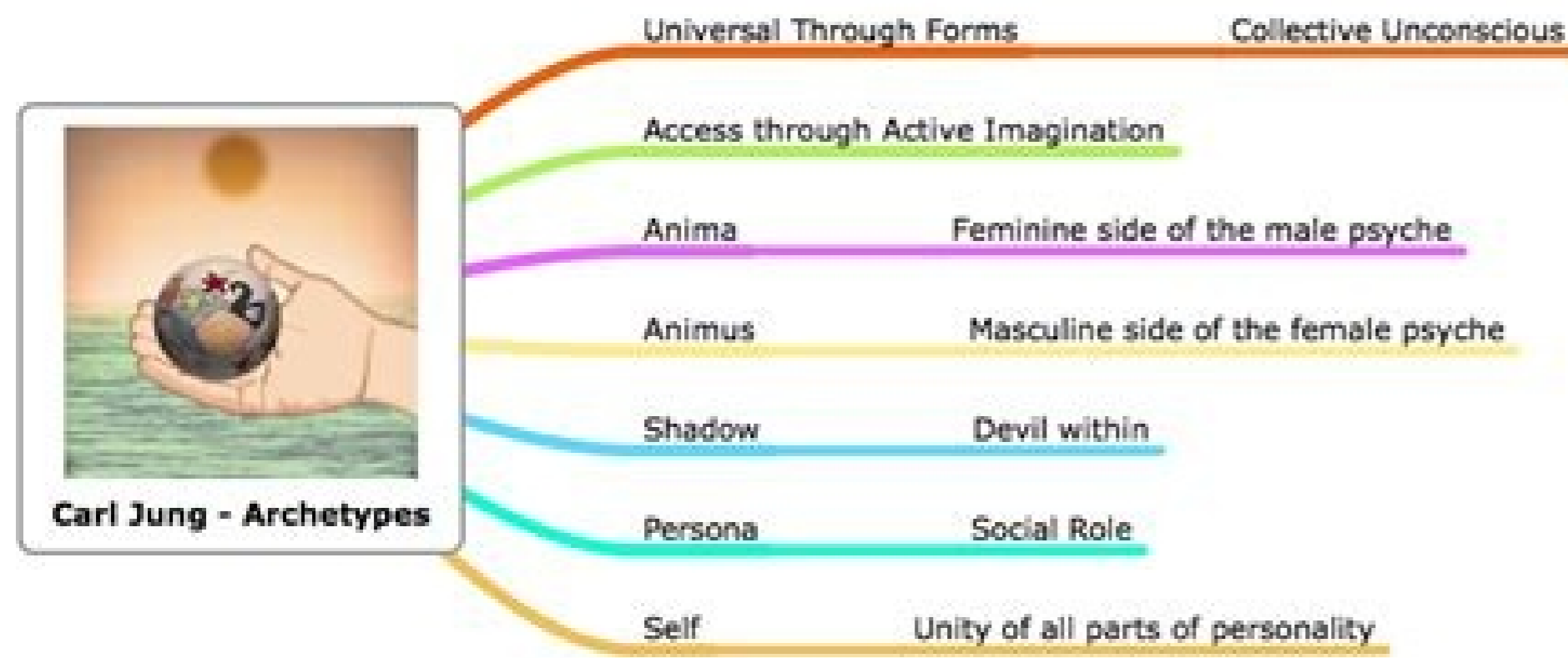

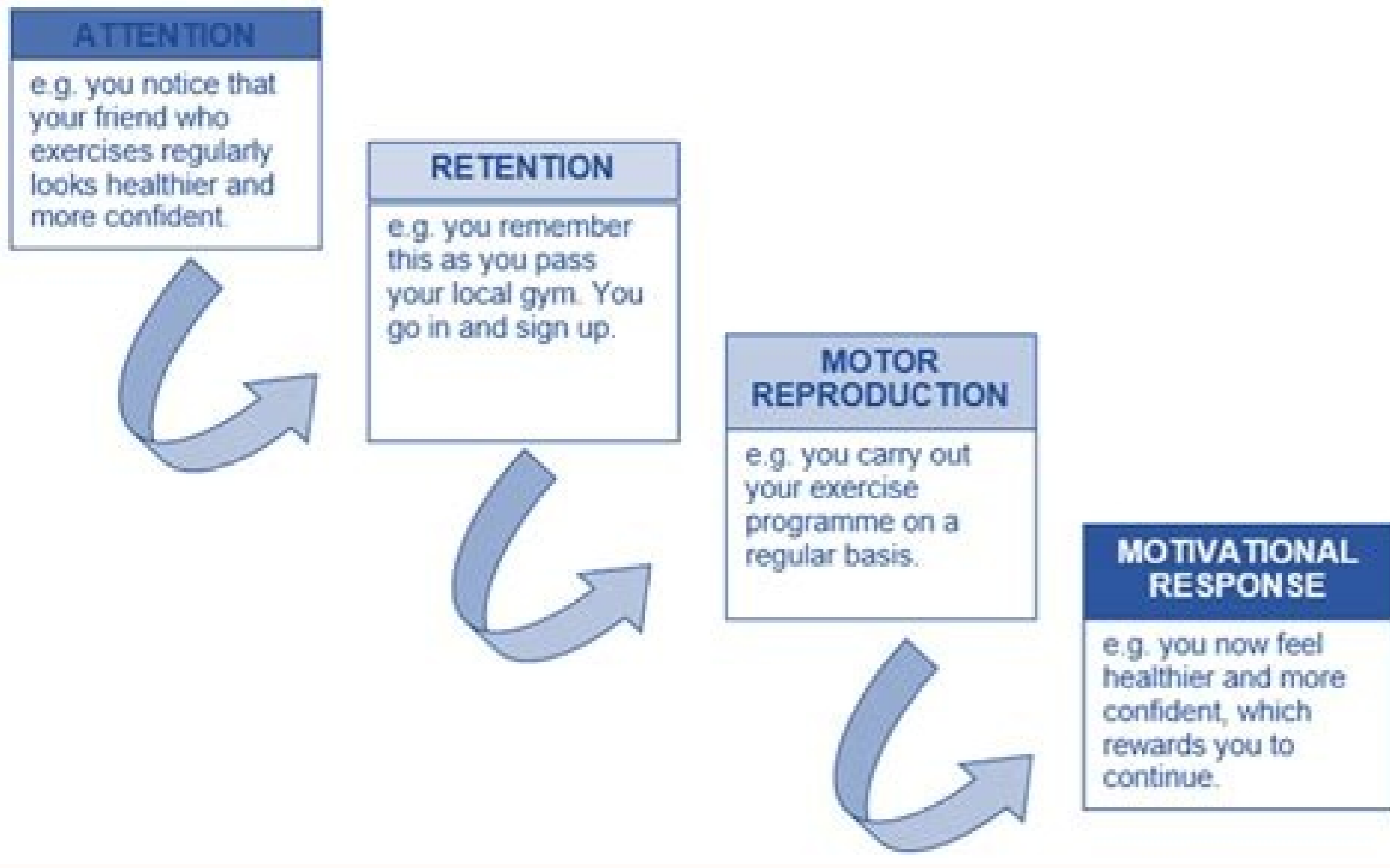

### Bandura's Four Step Modeling Process

Step	Process
1. Attention	Attention is the first step in the learning process. The learner must be aware of the behavior to be learned. If the model is interesting or there is a reward attached to the behavior, the learner is more likely to pay attention.
2. Retention	The learner must be able to store the information in memory. This is done through rehearsal and visualization. The learner must be able to recall the information when needed.
3. Reproduction	The learner must be able to reproduce the behavior. This is done through practice and feedback. The learner must be able to perform the behavior on their own.
4. Motivation	The learner must be motivated to perform the behavior. This is done through rewards and consequences. The learner must see the value in performing the behavior.
